Emergency rooms provide treatment of severe illnesses and life-threatening injuries.


Chinese

 - Loss of consciousness
 - Heavy bleeding



如何用英语描述身体的疼痛?









-ache

在医学英语中通常用来描述一种持续的、轻到中等强度的疼痛感。它常常表达某种身体部位的不适感,而不是剧烈的疼痛。例如:

- •头痛(Headache)
- •背痛 (Backache)
- •腹痛(Stomachache)
- •牙痛(Toothache)

这些表达都是用来描述一种持久的、不剧烈的 疼痛感,而非短暂和剧烈的痛感。



hurt动词



- I hurt my knee.
- My knee hurts.

SOTE 形容词



- My finger is sore.
- I have a sore finger.

pain 名词



- I have a back pain.
- I have a pain in my back.

Word	Definition	Usage Examples	Chinese Translation
Ache	持续的、钝痛感;强度较低 的疼痛	My tooth aches when I eat cold food.	我吃冷食时牙疼
Hurt	感觉到疼痛或不适;可以是 尖锐的痛感	My leg hurts after running.	我跑步后腿疼
Sore	表示由于炎症或过度使用而 产生的疼痛感	My muscles are sore after the workout	我的肌肉在锻炼后酸痛。
Pain	强烈或严重的疼痛; 可以是 锐痛或跳痛	I have a sharp pain in my side.	我的侧面有锐痛。
		The pain in my head is unbearable.	我头痛得难以忍受

Doctor: "Alright, I'm going to give you Ibuprofen to help reduce the swelling and pain. Take these for two days and come back for a follow-up after the swelling goes down."
